The attention of all the MCs are invited to the refs cited.

- 2. A 03 week long campaign from 7th March 2023 to 30th March 2023 to celebrate and galvanize the transition from 'Women in swachhata' to 'Women led swachhata' in all the ULBs. The components of Swachhotsav-2023 are as follows:
 - Women Icon Leading Swachhata (WINS) Awards 2023 to recognize and award women champions in sanitation and waste management.
 - Swachh Mashaal March- Ward-level mass mobilization of citizens led by women to be held on 29th March 2023 declared as "International day of Zero waste" by United Nations General Assemble
 - Garbage Free Cities Influencers' Network- To mainstream Women SHGs in taking the "Jan Andolan" for Garbage Free Cities
- 2. In view of the above, all the MCs are instructed to conduct Swachhotsav-2023 in concerned ULBs with following indicative activities:
- 2.1 Women Icon Leading Swachhata (WINS) Awards 2023:
 - Create awareness to the citizens regarding Women Icon Leading Swachhata (WINS)
 Awards 2023 through Social media, News paper, Posters, website etc.
 - Collect the applications for WINS awards from Individual women entrepreneurs, SHGs, NGOs, Startups and Micro entrepreneurs in required thematic areas from 15th March to 5th April 2023 and submit the best 5 nominations to undersigned on or before 30th April 2023.

2.2 GFC Influencers Network:

- Identify the enthusiastic women from each ward as "Swachhatta Agent" and to form a Ward Level Committee involving SHG women, Youth groups, Student groups, NGOs, etc by 25th March 2023.
- The Swachhatta agents will train the committee members on Anti-littering, source segregation and GFC messaging and promote sanitation and hygienic practices.

2.3 Swachh Mashaal March:

- To organize Swachh Mashaal March on 29th March 2023 A Ward level mass mobilization of citizens led by women, declared as "International day of Zero Waste"
- Identify 3-4 high footfall location(s) for conducting IEC activities in each ward.
- The committee led by Swachhatta Agent/ Ward Captain from each ward will conduct a ward level IEC programs such as Rallies, Pledges, Plog run, GVPs conversion etc involving citizen towards the goal of Garbage free Cities
- The elected representatives from each ward should participate in the IEC activities conducted by the Swachhatta Agent/ Ward Captain.
- 3. Hence, the Commissioner, GHMC, CEO, SCB and MCs of all ULBs, PD's/PD-DMC/TMC/ADMC, MEPMA are instructed to conduct Swachhotsav-2023 duly following the above timelines and ensure participation of women in large scale and conduct this campaign as a Zero Waste events. The detailed guidelines are hereby enclosed for ready reference.

Detailed guidelines for taking up Swachhotsav-2023 campaign (On the eve of International Women's Day Celebrations)

1. Women Icon Leading Swachhata (WINS) Awards 2023

ULB should recognize and celebrate women led organizations and individuals who are leading change in Urban sanitation and waste management through various indicatives Category of Applicants:

- a. Individual Women Entrepreneurs
- b. Self Help Groups
- c. Micro Enterprises
- d. Startups
- e. NGOs

Ten Thematic Areas:

- a. Management of Community/Public Toilets,
- b. Septic tank cleaning services
- c. Treatment facilities Used Water / Septage
- d. Municipal Waste Collection & Transportation
- e. MRF Operation
- f. Waste to Wealth products
- g. Treatment Facilities-Solid Waste Management
- h. Information Education Communication, Training Capacity Building
- i. Technology and Innovation
- j. Other (to be specified)

Application Process for WINS award 2023:

Stage 1: Citizen Application

States & Cities to publicize details of WINS Awards 2023 via their website, portals, and social media. ULB's to encourage citizens to show effective participation through the suggested application format is enclosed.

Stage 2: City Evaluation Stage

ULBs will evaluate entries & nominate up to 5 applicants to the State via the Swachhatam portal. ULBs can organize public felicitation of their nominees - as city winners.

Stage 3: State Nomination

ULB wise nominations will be evaluated at the State level. Up to 3 entries in each category will be nominated by the State to MoHUA and State will organize public felicitation of nominees rewarded as State winners.

Stage 4: MoHUA Evaluation

State nominations will be evaluated at the national level on their innovativeness, impact, uniqueness, sustainability & replicability. An award ceremony will be organized at central level to felicitate the winner considering the mentioned criteria and encourage 'Women led Swachhata'.

Stage 5: Award Ceremony

City, State, and National Awards Ceremony will be organized tentatively around 5th June (World Environment Day).

The Swachhatta agents will train the committee members on Anti-littering, Sources segregation and GFC messaging and promote sanitation and hygienic practices.

Every ULB should encourage the creation of Waste to Wealth Enterprises.

3. Swachh Mashaal March

Swachh Mashaal March-A ward-level mass mobilization of citizens led by women held on 30th March 2023 declared as international day of Zero waste by United Nations General Assemble

Pre-Event list:

- ULB should express interest in Swachh Mashaal March from 13th March till 27th March 2023 via email or Google Form.
- Every ULB should identify women Ward Captains to lead this activity in every ward.
- Every ULB should conduct max volunteer registration in ward level for this IEC activity.
- All age groups and genders are welcome to participate in this event.

- Every ULB should publish the Activity time, date, and location in every ward with Ward Captain.
- The elected representatives from each ward should participate in the IEC activities conducted by the Ward Captain.

Event Day (29th March 2023):

- Every ULB should do Live social media tweeting during activities in Ward level.
- Every ULB should Identify 3-4 high footfall location(s) for the conducting IEC activities in each ward.
- The committee led by Ward Captain from each ward will conduct a ward level IEC program such as Rallies/Marches, Pledges, Plog run, Converting GVPs, etc involving citizen towards the goal of Garbage free Cities.
- Every Ward Captains to lead cleanliness drives & spread awareness regarding 'zero waste', source segregation, & composting in ULB.
- Every ULB should record the number of participants in activities.
- Every ULB should take Swachhata Pledges in all the participants in every wards that take place on 29th March 2023.

Micro events:

- Melas of zero waste products created by SHG members
- Zero waste food stalls
- Waste to wealth competitions
- Community dialogues and local meetings/events by community women leaders
- Debates and Discussions with Women Entrepreneurs, NGOs, Startups, Individual Women entrepreneur, Citizens etc created from waste.
- Song and Drama Division activities, folk performances, puppet shows, Drawing Competitions, Wall Paintings, Etc

Every ULB should conduct this event as "Zero Waste event".

- ✓ Host cities: to cover local travel, boarding and lodging of Yatris. It can be booked under IEC/CB component of SBM (U) 2.0.

Role of host States and Cities

- ✓ Site visits for Swachhata

 Doots to learn about innovative sanitation models and facilitate sharing of best practices.
- ✓ **Documentation** of the tour to be undertaken by host cities.

Role of Guest States and Cities

- ✓ SBM/DAY-NULM coordinators to provide overall coordination & to travel to host cities.
- ✓ Each State Directorate of DAY-NULM to **select 10 women (approx.) ALF/SHG members** to travel to the host city as Swachhata Doots to cross learn and share best practices.
- ✓ Women political leadership from the guest State/UT may flag off the journey of Swachhata Doots.
- ✓ **Documentation** of the tour to be undertaken by the Yatris. (Template to be shared by MOHUA)
- ✓ Within a week of the Yatra, cities to organize a debriefing session with Swachhata Doots, political leadership and relevant key stakeholders.

To mainstream SHGs and their federations as partners in implementing SBM-U 2.0. These master trainers will act as swachhata agents at the community level to generate awareness regarding the Mission's goal.

- ✓ MoHUA to conduct an online training of master trainers consisting of members from Area Level Federation & City Level Federation
- ✓ From each State/UT 2,500 to 3,000 master trainers to join the training.
- ✓ Objective is to **instill a sense of community involvement** towards the city's sanitation services.
- ✓ **Master trainers to further train women SHG** members on sanitation. Cities to focus on sanitation in the SHG's calendar of activities.
- ✓ Training to focus on anti-littering, **source segregation and GFC messaging** and promote sanitation and hygienic practices.
- ✓ Creation of waste to wealth enterprises will also be encouraged.
- ✓ Goal is to activate 75,000 GFC Influencers in March 2023.
