In continuation of this office Circular vide reference 6th cited, it is to inform that during the Video Conference convened by C&DMA on 18.06.2016, certain Municipal Commissioners have informed that the format containing 105 columns for conducting GIS based survey is little lengthy in which the information relating to 25 assessments per day may not be possible and that the College Students engaged in conducting survey are requesting for payment of remuneration for the work being performed by them.

- 2. Though the format is a little lengthy, the C&DMA during the said Video Conference has expressed that the data can be captured and computerized at a time and the un-assessed and under-assessments can be brought into tax net and the demand can be increased.
- 3. The undersigned has explained the reasons and importance for capturing and computerization of data at a time and directed to deploy three Students in each of the team with a remuneration of upto Rs. 5/- per each assessment per student as per their feasibility, who shall cover each of the items viz. Property Tax, Water Supply & D & O Trade etc. in the respective allotted teams, one followed by the other (OR) to deploy additional teams so as to cover at the rate of 20 assessments by each team instead of 25 assessments. The expenditure towards remuneration of the students may be met from the General funds of the ULBs duly following the procedure. The Municipal Commissioners shall explore option of utilizing the services of Engineering Staff viz., Fitter, Lineman etc. for Water Tax and Sanitary Jawans for and for D&O Trade license.

4. The Municipal Commissioners of all the ULBs are therefore directed to take necessary action to complete the GIS based taxation survey in the prescribed 105 columns format and capture and computerize the same in e-Suvidha module on a daily basis without fail.
