in the process of development of nurseries-Certain instructions-

2. This Office Lr.Roc.No.10869/2018-H2, Dt.22.10.2017 addressed to all the
Municipal Commissioners in the State.

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You are all aware that the Hon'ble Chief Minister has time and again issued instructions to develop nurseries in the Municipalities for taking up plantations during Haritha Haram programmes in this regard detailed instructions were issued vide references cited for development of centralized nurseries in the Municipalities.

2. In continuation to the above instructions and in order to involve public particularly the SHG women in the process of development of nurseries it has been decided to develop homestead nurseries by SHG members for distribution during Haritha Haram programme. The following are the detailed guidelines for developing homestead nurseries.

1. The Municipal Commissioner / PD, MEPMA in consultation with DMC / TMC shall identify SHG women members who have either experience / interested in developing homestead nurseries
2. Each member shall raise 500 to 1000 plants in the nurseries.
3. There shall be suitable land available in the premises of the member with proper fencing and water supply.
4. The SHG member shall bear the cost of the seedlings and polythene bag and take care of the plant until it grows to minimum 2 feet

height. It shall be the responsibility of the SHG member for nurturing the plant.

5. After growing the plant in the nursery the healthy plant shall be bought back by the Municipal Commissioners @ of Rs.10.00 per every healthy surviving plant for taking up plantations during Haritha Haram programme.
6. If the SHG member is unable to put the initial capital cost for raising the plants, a loan may be arranged from SHG / SLF /TLF by co-ordinating with MEPMA staff.
7. The amount payable to the SHG member by the Municipal Commissioner @ of Rs.10.00 for every healthy and surviving plant shall be directly transferred to the bank account of the SHG member and shall not involve any cash transactions.
8. Separate instructions shall be issued regarding geo tagging of the above homestead nurseries and MIS formats.
9. There shall be atleast 7 to 10 homestead nurseries based on the above guidelines in each municipality without fail.
10. Funds will be released to ULBs maximum upto 10 homestead nurseries @ of 1000 plants for each nursery.
11. Seperate guidelines shall be issued regarding purchasing of seedlings and plastic bags.
12. Necessary compost required for the development of nurseries shall be supplied by the Municipal Commissioners to the SHG members.

I request you to follow the above guidelines and identify members of SHGs for developing homestead nurseries for taking up mass plantations during the month of September-2018 in the ULBs and make the programme more successful with the involvement of public, elected representatives etc.,. The formats for furnishing the required data is enclosed for taking necessary action in the matter.
