CIRCULAR

Sub: Municipal Councils-Telangana State-Water Supply- Provision of House Service Connection (HSCs) for Rs 1/-only instead of Rs.200/- to the BPL Households in the limits of all ULBs- Government Orders communicated-Certain instructions issued-Reg.

Ref: G.O.Rt.No.372 MA & UD Dept, Dt.24.05.2016

The attentions of all the Commissioners of Municipal Corporations and Municipal Commissioners of Municipalities / Nagarpanchayats are invited to the references cited, wherein the Government in the reference cited, hereby adopted the condition of identifying the below poverty line group households i.e., whose annual income is less than Rs.1.50 Lakhs in Rural Areas and Rs.2.00 Lakhs per Annum in Urban Areas in the State, issued by the PR & RD Dept vide G.O.Ms.No.23, PR & RD Dept, Dt.25.11.2014 and accordingly order that any Below Poverty Line group households who are not having access to drinking water tap connection, shall be granted one House Service Connection on payment of Re-1/- (Rupee One Only) instead of Rs.200/- in all the Municipal Councils, Municipalities and Municipal Corporations in the State.

- 2. Further, the following instructions are given for strict compliance:
 - i. Divide the town into three zones:

a. Green Zone

- Where pipe lines are already existing and un-authorized connections are also existing

b. Blue Zone - Potential area with existing infrastructure.
Needs extending of pipe lines.

c. Red Zone - Not feasible with existing infrastructure, preparatory work desirable under Mission Bhagiratha

- ii. Constitution of teams and necessary preparatory work for conducting survey and MELAS.
- iiia) Survey and Identification of unauthorized connections in Green Zone, taking applications to regularize the tap connection and issuing proceedings by 08.06.2016.

b) Survey and identifying BPL & APL where extension of pipelines is required to release new connection.

- c) Survey and identification of households of APL & BPL in red zone where there is no infrastructure but applications should be collected to assess the number of connections to be released under Mission Bhagiratha
- iv. Tabulation of the data separately for APL & BPL Hose holds for:
 - a. List of un-authorized tap connections
 - b. List of immediate households, where HSC can be released immediately.
 - c. List of connections under Mission Bhagiratha
 - d. List of grievances for existing customers
- v. Each team shall conduct a MELA in their allotted area either ward wise or tank wise as per the instructions of the Municipal Commissioner
- vi. Computing the above data Zone wise / Ward wise for preparing tentative list of unauthorized connections and prospective new connections.
- vii. Regularization of illegal connection on mission mode by above teams distributing HSC proceedings involving local elected representatives on 08.06.2016
- viii. Preparation of tentative estimates and cost involved to provide infrastructure in Red Zone
- ix. Submission of final report by 9th June (09.06.2016)
- 3. Therefore all the Municipal Commissioners are hereby by instructed to follow the orders of the Government vide reference cited and also the above instructions scrupulously without any deviation.
