<u>ORDER</u>:

Government of Telangana has launched the Swachh Bharat - Swachh Telangana Mission on the line of Swachh Bharat Guidelines and is committed to achieve the goal of the Mission in all the Urban Local Bodies of the State. As per the Government of India Guidelines, the following are the other components of the Swachh Bharat Mission:

- i. Construction of Community Toilets.
- ii. Solid Waste Management.
- iii. Capacity Building and A&OE.
- iv. Public Awareness and IEC.

2. The Commissioner and Director of Municipal Administration, Telangana State, Hyderabad has stated that as per the above guidelines action plan under Swachh Bharat for the Mission period 2015 to 2019 has been prepared keeping in view the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and also to comply the provision of eradication of Manual Scavengers Act, 2013 as sanitary latrines and Community latrines will be constructed in the scheme to prevent open defecation and existence insanitary toilets and submitted to Government of India with an estimated amount of Rs.900.49 Crores for under taking construction of individual toilets and above four components for sanction and release of Government of India share of Rs.244.19 Crores for the above activities.

The Commissioner and Director of Municipal Administration, Telangana State, 3. Hyderabad has also stated that the tentative cost for construction of individual toilet (Twin pit latrine) is Rs.15000/- as per SBM guidelines and Central Government incentive for the Construction of individual household toilet is Rs.4000/- per unit. The mandatory contribution from the State Government share is 25% of Central Share i.e., Rs.1000/- per unit, which comes as Rs.5000/-(Central Rs.4000 + State Rs.1000/-) in the SBM guidelines it was informed to meet remaining amount of Rs.10000/- by State Government or beneficiary contribution. After detailed deliberations on the State share and Individual beneficiary contribution for construction of individual toilets, it has been decided to enhance the State Share for construction of individual toilets to Rs.8000/- and remaining Rs.3000/- as a beneficiary share. As such an amount of Rs 288.21 Crores is required as State Government share for a period of 5 years for all the above 4 components. Amount of Rs 7.10 Crores is required for one year 2014-15 and state Government share is Rs.41.54 Crores for first year i.e 2014-15. The Government of India have already released its share of Rs.28.95 Crores for the five above mentioned components for 2014-15.

4. The Commissioner and Director of Municipal Administration, Telangana State, Hyderabad has therefore requested the orders of the Government on the following:

- i. Sanction Rs.8000/- per unit as State share towards construction of 43050 Nos. of individual household toilets costing Rs.34.44 Crores for first year 2014-15 under SBM and permit to utilize the amount available under State Finance Commission budget for the year Financial Year 2015-16 and BPS/LRS funds available with ULBs towards State share.
- ii. Sanction of Rs.7.10 Crores towards State share for first year (2014-15) for taking up all the 4 components (i.e., Community Toilets Rs.2.01Crores, Solid Waste Management Rs.3.81 Crores, IEC & Awareness Rs.1.02 Crores and Capacity Building and A&OE Rs.0.26 Crores) and permit to utilize the amount available under State Finance Commission budget for the year 2015-16 and BPS/LRS funds available with ULBs towards State share.

5. Government after careful examination of the matter hereby approve the proposal of the Commissioner and Director of Municipal Administration, Telangana State at para-4 above.

6. The Commissioner and Director of Municipal Administration, Telangana State, Hyderabad shall take necessary further action accordingly in the matter.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (EBS.VIII) department vide their U.O.No.4637/156/EBS.VIII/2015, Dated:22.04.2015.
